Gentlemen;

I herewith submit my twenty-first annual report of the activities of the Fire Department.

The Department responded to 1470 calls. This is a decrease of 237 or 13.8 % less than the number of calls received the previous year.

The fire loss for the year amounted to \$ 163,589.28 (This does not include an estimated loss of \$100,000. on the Stevens Ave. Armory, a building under Federal jurisdiction.) This is \$ 49,669.46 or 23.2 % less than for the year 1944.

There were 133 actual building fires, of which 30 resulted in losses of more than \$ 1,000 per fire.

These 30 fires or 22.5 % of the building fires, accounted for \$ 138,990.29 or 84.9 % of the loss.

The other 103 building fires were extinguished with an average loss of \$ 238.82 per fire.

June 9, fire at 164 Grant St. Theodore M. Small, aged 11 months, Suffocated.



On account of the war and limited supply of material, the underground activities were confined to maintenance of existing plant.

A transformer vault was constructed in the F. W. Woolworth building on Congress Street in which were installed 3 - 100 KVA transformers.

New England Telephone & Telegraph Co.

The following is a report of major improvements in the plant of the New England Telephone & Telegraph Company in the City of Portland which were made during the year 1945.

A new conduit system was placed from Congress Street to the Union Station.

New inside cable, replacing old and deteriorated wires, was installed in the buildings #218 to 238, inclusive, on Federal Street.

Obsolete and inadequate cable was replaced with new cable in the Graymore Hotel.

A new 1212 Pr. cable was placed between the Telephone building at 45 Forest Avenue and Woodfords Corner via Forest Avenue; a 404 Pr. cable was placed on Falmouth Street from Forest Avenue to Brighton Avenue; a 606 Pr. cable was placed from Woodfords Corner via Woodford Street to Glenwood Avenue; a 606 Pr. cable was placed from Forest Avenue to Sawyer Street via Ocean Avenue; and a 303 Pr. cable was placed from Stevens Avenue to Fellows Street. These cables are all placed in underground conduit and splicing is now underway. The completion of this project will provide additional facilities for service in a large portion of the west and north section of Portland.

The replacement of jointly owned poles with the Central Maine Power Company was made as appeared desirable, although no wholesale replacements of poles were made during 1945.

Recommendations

A fund of \$ 16,000. has been set up for expanding the fire alarm system.

I recommend that an amount of \$ 15,000. be added to it in order to carry out the project.

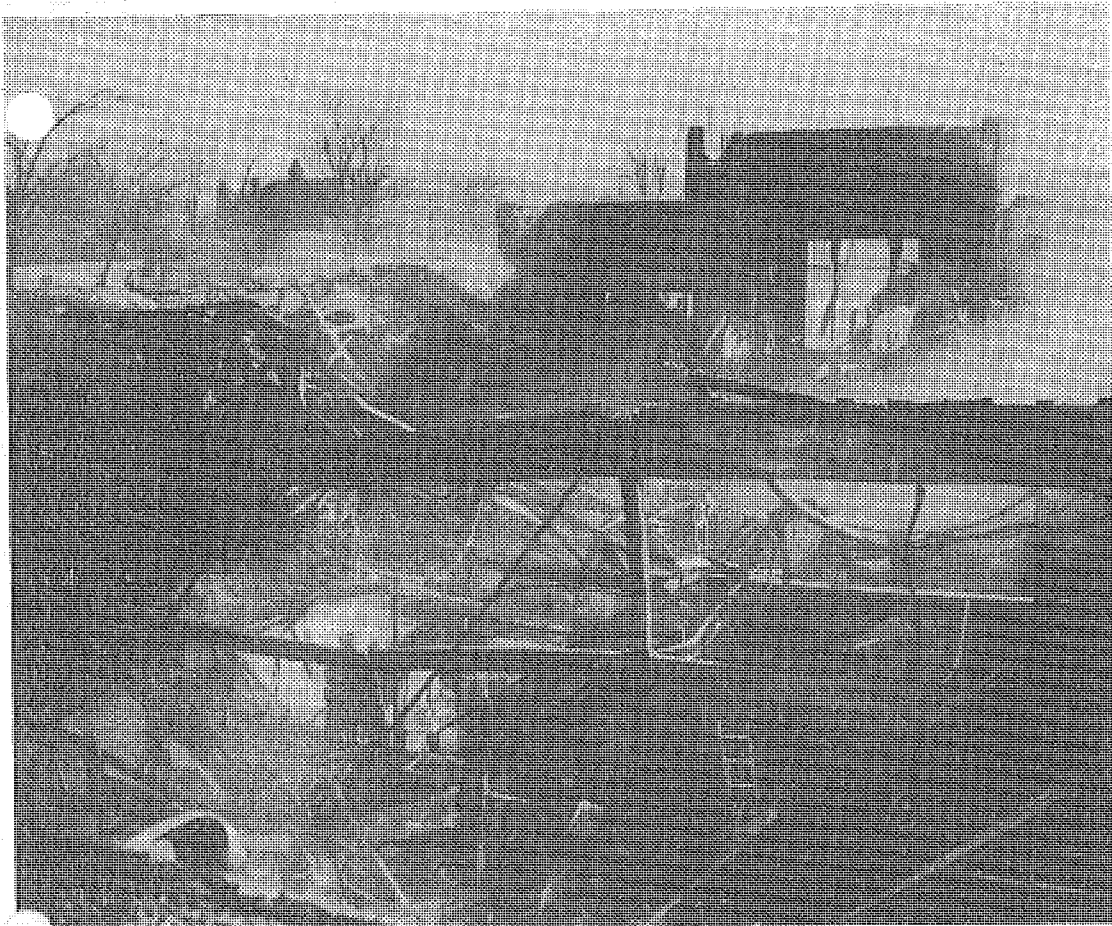

at 2 a. m. by Daniel Felix of 23 Hollis Road en route to his home from work.

A second alarm, from Box 922, was pulled by Police Patrolman John Douglass at 2.10, with the third call coming 10 minutes later.

Fanned By Wind

Fanned by a strong wind which at times reached gust peaks of 20 miles an hour, the flames quickly enveloped the main section of the two-story building, spreading showers of flying sparks on nearby rooftops.

The death-dealing explosion came, Chief Sanborn said, as members of Engine 8 fought the conflagration close to the north wall.

The chief said he had just sent Elmer MacKenzie, a fireman, to get an additional line of hose, when the brick wall exploded with a sickening crash.

"The blast nearly knocked me off my feet," Sanborn said. "Then I heard screams, and turned around and saw the three men in the debris."

"Walsh was found dead when his body was uncovered," he said.

Flaherty and Thurlow were taken to the Maine General Hospital in one of several police ambulances stationed at the scene by Capt. Harold K. Maguire.

At the hospital, Flaherty was treated for injuries to the left arm and later was discharged. Thurlow was hospitalized for a compound fracture of the right foot.

Police Sgt. John J. O'Brien, on duty at the scene, received a leg injury when struck by a hose, and later was given first aid treatment at the Maine General Hospital.

28 Perish In 25 Days

The death of Fireman Thomas L. Walsh at the Stevens Avenue Armory conflagration brought to 28 the number of Maine fire casualties within the past 25 days.

The State's fire death toll in that period included: Jan. 31, Auburn baby home, 17 dead; Feb. 6, Lewiston residence, three dead; Feb. 7, Pittsfield mill, three killed; Feb. 11, Machas residence, one dead; Feb. 13, Waterville hotel, two killed, and Feb. 21, Kittery residence, one dead.

Hampered by heat so intense it could be felt more than a block away, firemen fought the blaze from every possible vantage point and were able to save from total destruction a garage and drill hall located in the rear.

Flames Shot Up 100 Feet

Flying embers, described by Ann Wagner, a Westbrook Junior College student, as "great balls of fire," shot nearly 100 feet into the early morning air, endangering numerous dwellings to the east of the armory in the Forest Avenue sector.

Chief Sanborn said he had been informed that two quarts of type-writer cleaning fluid had been kept in a second-floor office where the explosion apparently occurred. This fluid was highly inflammable, he said, and could have caused the blast since it could have had the force of "about four pounds of dynamite."

During the height of the fire spectators scattered and firemen crouched low as small arms ammunition in the building exploded from the heat of the flames. No one was injured by the flying bullets.

Major Walter S. Hill, officer in charge of the Induction Center, said all equipment and records of his service were lost in the fire.

Major Hill said copies of individual Selective Service records were "kept elsewhere," but added that equipment loss would be heavy.

The Induction Center's greatest loss was sustained in its medical examination section, where the X-ray room, totally loaded, X-ray equipment and other medical supplies were destroyed.

Hill said the next group of inductees had been scheduled for examination March 9 and that no plans had been made as yet for a new site for the center.

Major Henry Beverage, Civil Air Patrol executive officer, said CAP equipment loss would total nearly \$3,000. This, he said, included equipment owned by members and an equal amount allocated to it by the Army.

Lt. Col. Ellis F. Hight, commander of the 1st Battalion, Maine State Guard, said his organization lost full equipment for two companies of 100 men and 12 officers, including guns and uniforms.

Plans Irreplaceable

Hight said MSG records destroyed were kept at Augusta in duplicate but many unduplicated "secret plans" made for "possible emergencies" were

Probe Board Named

AUGUSTA, Feb. 24 (Special)—A State Board of Inquiry, composed of five State military officers, was appointed today by Adjutant General George M. Carter immediately after he learned of the fire at the Stevens Avenue Armory, Portland.

Named to the Board were Col. John F. Choats of Winslow, State ordnance officer, chairman; Lt. Col. Carl F. Fellows, Augusta, judge advocate of the Maine State Guard; Lt. Col. Ellis F. Hight, Portland, commanding officer of the First Battalion, State Guard; Major Albert H. Wilson, Jr., Portland, executive officer, First Battalion; and Capt. Reginald S. Gammon, Portland, commanding officer, Company A.

The board will "probably" meet Monday, Col. Lester M. Hart, assistant adjutant general, said today.

lost. Some of these secret plans were irreplaceable, Hight said.

The Portland CAP squadron, occupied two rooms in the building and had use of classrooms and the drill hall.

Lost records, Capt. Carroll H. Ripley said, included correspondence on training programs and the progress of work of the units.

Most important loss, Ripley said, were six transmitters and receivers, individually owned, which were used in mobile units and planes.

Jean Farrern and Jean Fleischer, third-floor occupants of Houghton Hall, Westbrook Junior College dormitory, located across the street from the armory, were awakened in the night by the smell of smoke, and in turn rushed through the building to arouse the 30 other students in the dormitory.

Dean Elsbeth Melville was summoned from her residence nearby and she ordered the girls to dress and gather their valuables together. Throughout the height of the fire, the students remained on the first floor.

Westbrook Junior College maintenance crews guarded the college's several buildings in the area.

F. E. Lyons, a nearby Stevens Avenue resident, said that at the fire's peak "the air was filled with great showers of flying embers which swept the rooftops as far as Forest Avenue."

Left At 8.30 P. M.

David Reynar of 764 Stevens Avenue, caretaker at the armory, said he left the building at 8.30 Friday evening with "everything in order."

The caretaker explained that he usually started his work at the building at 5.30 each morning and stayed "until I felt it was OK to leave."

Army officials said that when they opened one or two safes in the building this forenoon they found that \$125 in bills in one of the strongboxes had been destroyed by the intense heat.

The death of Walsh and injury to Flaherty and Thurlow put Engine 8 at Woodfords out of commission for the time being, Chief Sanborn said.

Walsh, a member of the department since 1936, was born in Portland, in 1906, the son of the late Michael Walsh and Mrs. Mary Walsh Coyne. He was a graduate of Cheverus High School and prior to joining the department had been employed as a painter.

A provisional fireman for two years, Walsh was made a permanent member on Feb. 7, 1938.

Surviving, besides the mother, are the widow, Mrs. Ethel Miller Walsh; two daughters, Jane Ann, 13, and Mary Lou, 10; a brother, John P. Walsh, chief petty officer, Coast Guard, stationed in Baltimore, and a half brother, Francis Coyne, serving with the Army in France.

Leaving a single watch line at the scene as a precautionary measure, Chief Sanborn ordered the recall sounded at 11.34 a. m.

Built on the site of the old Cumberland Light and Power Company carbarn, the Armory was submitted to the Maine State Defense Commission in January, 1942.

Constructed at a cost of \$141,000, the new building included some of the old structure. A new entrance and facade was added as well as a wing, 95 by 150 feet, on the south side.

The central section was divided into offices, dressing rooms, equipment rooms and locker rooms.

A large drill shed, kitchen, rifle range and truck garage were located in the wings.

Use of the carbarn as an armory site was approved by the Portland City Council in 1940 when provisions of the zoning ordinance, which prohibited such construction in that area, were waived through "the courtesy of the City."

The building had been used as headquarters for the Portland Armed Services Induction District since

caliber, was exploded, scattering the large crowd in all directions.

As the blaze continued, its rage was intermittently punctuated with other powerful explosions, one of which blew out the front of the building.

The flames accompanied by dense clouds of smoke, lit the night spectacularly, attracting hundreds of citizens from their beds and flooding the Press Herald office with telephone calls.

The flames leaped more than 40 feet in the air.

Witnesses who arrived at the scene shortly after the first alarm sounded about 2 a. m. said that flames were leaping from the central portion of the building but that as firemen played the first streams of water upon them they appeared to subside.

However, smoke began to roll from the rear and right wing of the structure as the flames died and in a few moments the rosy fury of flames could be discerned at the rear of the building.

From the rear the fury of the blaze increased, spreading through both wings and into the front of the doomed structure. Flames shot out of the front windows more than 40 feet in the air.

Police Sergeant John J. O'Brien, directing a crew of police at the scene, suffered a leg injury when a hose struck him as it was dragged by a truck. He refused first aid and stayed on the job.

The first alarm was turned in from Box 925 at Morrill's Corner by Daniel Felix of 23 Hollis Road as he walked home from the Southworth Machine Company where he is employed. He was attracted by the smell of smoke and the second alarm from Box 922 was sounded by Patrolman John Douglas when he arrived in a cruiser car about 10 minutes later at about 2.10 a. m. and the third alarm was ordered by Chief Sanborn at 2.20 a. m.

The Armory, turned over to the State early in 1942, has been the headquarters for the Portland Armed Services Induction District since shortly after inauguration of the Selective Service Program and thousands of Maine men have been inducted there;

It also has housed the local headquarters of the State Guard and has been headquarters for the WAC recruiting office.

The central section of the building housed offices, dressing rooms, equipment quarters and locker rooms. A large drill shed, kitchen, rifle range and truck storage sheds are in the two wings.

The fire still was burning stubbornly, coming under control at 4 a. m. today.
